The last word in our sermon serious on Gifts of the Spirit is joy. It is a great word. When I was told I could get my first Covid vaccine I felt such a rush of joy. My body felt lighter without the worry of contracting the virus. The second vaccine sealed the deal and I joyfully checked off the days on the calendar until I had fulfilled my two weeks. Soon I can hold my new

grandson and hug my granddaughter. I am still careful. I mask and distance and avoid crowded places. I know I am protected but I could carry the virus to others. That has been the most puzzling aspect of the pandemic for me. Why would you risk the health of other people in fulfilling your own wants and needs. Why would you buy way more toilet paper than you could use in a year? Why has a serious, potentially life threatening, illness been the cause of so much dissention?


It is with joy that we opened to in person worship and joy that many are still worshipping with us on television and the web. It is with joy that we can worship on Easter together. Last year we had no in person Easter service. Like the Grinch who stole Christmas we realized that Easter came without all of the usual traditions we expected. We still celebrated Jesus' resurrection with joy. And that is what the journey of Lent was all about. It was about cleaning out the closets of our souls to prepare ourselves for the full- hearted joy of Easter. It is like the release experienced from the worry of Covid. It is a tension that our bodies carried. Waking up on Easter morning and being reminded that Jesus has guaranteed our salvation, is a cause for great and unending joy.

I have prayed that the other words of the Spirit's fruits of a faith life have touched you as they touched me each week. Every word of love, joy peace patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, and self-control has led me to self-examination and soul searching. Writing a sermon for each word helped me to delve into my own actions and responses. Though it was not done for us to receive a grade, I think my report card would say needs improvement. There is no shame in this or feeling of failure. It is a good and healthy thing to soul search. To be aware of what we struggle with in living as faithfully as we can.

Lent is ending on Sunday to make way for the joy of Easter. I am ready for unabashed exultant joy and celebration. How about you? I pray that the last word you live with this Lenten season is joy. Joy in a god who loves us no matter what and loves us when we realize there is room for improvement. As Easter people may we seek and find joy each and every day.
